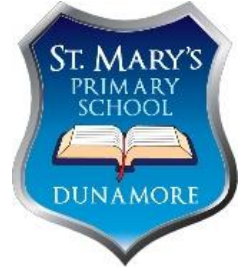


# St. Mary's News February 2024



Dear Parents,

The past few weeks have been a busy time for all the pupils in the school. The pupils are working hard and are participating in a wide range of learning experiences.

## **Morning Supervision**

Pupils arriving into school from 8.30am to 8.45am must go to the Assembly Hall where they will be supervised by staff members on morning duty. At 8.45am, pupils are escorted from the Assembly Hall to their classrooms by their class teacher. Pupils arriving after this time are to go directly to their classrooms. Children should NOT be dropped any earlier than 8.30am.

It is important that all pupils are in school for 9.15am as lessons begin promptly. We strongly encourage all pupils to arrive promptly to school as late comers can be disruptive to the teaching and learning. Pupils arriving after 9.20am will be marked late on the SIMS register.

## **Safeguarding for All**

In the interests of good safeguarding practices:

- Parents/guardians are asked to report to the general office if you are collecting your child early from school and sign the pupil out
- Visitors coming in to the school are to report to the general office and sign the Visitors Book.
- Unless you have been instructed to do so (e.g. in the case of Emergency First Aid) no adult/parent/guardian should walk down the corridor which leads to the main teaching area: including classrooms, resource area, computer suite and staff room at any time of the school day when pupils are about.



Could I also remind all parents/guardians to park in spaces to the left-hand side as you enter the school gates. Staff parking is available to the right of the gate. There have been on occasions over recent weeks where the buses have been unable to enter the school grounds easily due to a build-up of traffic. To ensure the safety of everyone, I ask for your cooperation in this matter, both at the morning drop off and home-times.

It is great to see so many children in their full school uniform looking so neat and tidy. Hoodies, half zips and skinnies etc should not be worn to school.

### **Catholic Schools' Week (21st January - 27<sup>th</sup> January 2024)**
